SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Dayshift began with several calls for service pending. Units were steady with these calls and one day shift unit was busy in criminal court most of the day. A male subject was reported in the 2000 Block of Golf Rd potentially looking to jump onto the freeway below. Several officers and CHP were involved and the male eventually walked off of the overpass and was detained for a mental health evaluation. A domestic assault and battery occurred near the intersection of W Main St and Kilroy Rd. The victim was beaten several times by her boyfriend resulting in obvious injuries to her face and head. The victim tried to call 9-1-1 and the male continued to beat her. There was also an active restraining order protecting the victim that the male violated. The male was identified, although as Officers arrived and he was not located. An I&B was issued for his arrest listing several felonies.
